**YOUTH IN PHILANTHROPY**

This award is presented to an individual or group of young people, age 23 or younger, whose voluntary fundraising efforts have demonstrated the spirit of philanthropy and have set an example for others to follow.

**CORPORATE PHILANTHROPIST OF THE YEAR**

This award is presented to a local corporation or civic organization which has shown outstanding community spirit and commitment to the goals of building a better community for all citizens through contributions to charitable causes and endeavors, taking an active role in community improvement activities, and by encouraging volunteerism and community involvement among its members.

**LEADERSHIP FUNDRAISER OF THE YEAR**

This award is presented to an individual demonstrating exceptional leadership skills in coordinating and motivating volunteers for major fund-raising projects of more than one not-for-profit organization. By generously giving of his/her time and talents, this person makes a measurable impact on the Chattanooga community and the advancement of philanthropy.

**OUTSTANDING PHILANTHROPIST AWARD**
