Job Summary:

The Development Director works closely with the Chief Development Officer, Board Chair, Staff, and Board of Directors in all development and fundraising endeavors.

- Identify, cultivate, and solicit new major donors and planned gifts.
- Maintain and enhance relationships with current major donors.
- Manage and steward donor database (Currently DonorPerfect), ensuring that all gifts are accurately recorded, acknowledged, and tracked.
- Research and identify new funding opportunities, including foundation and corporate grants.
- Work closely with the Board Chair and Board of Directors to develop and implement fundraising strategies and plans.
- Write compelling grant proposals that align with the mission and priorities of Ice in Paradise.
- Cultivate and maintain relationships with current and prospective donors, including individuals, corporations, municipalities, and foundations.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in nonprofit management, communication, business administration, or a related field preferred.
- Minimum of 3-5 years of demonstrated success in nonprofit fundraising and donor engagement.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills, including the ability to write compelling grant proposals and fundraising appeals.
