



AFP-Greater Atlanta Chapter National Philanthropy Day Awards Program

Guidelines for Submitting Nominations

1. Nominations for any award may be submitted by an individual AFP member, an AFP organization or non-member individual or organization.
2. The deadline for nominations for AFP – Greater Atlanta Chapter’s Awards for National Philanthropy Day is Friday, March 6, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. EST. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. All nominations MUST be submitted using the forms available on the AFP- Greater Atlanta Chapter website and sent via email. Nominators should use the corresponding form for each award category and follow the instructions listed on the form. When the form is complete, please attach your document(s) to an email and send to jbrown@asginfo.net.
4. All nominations MUST address all of the criteria set out for each award. Narratives should contain complete, clear and concise answers. Answers to each question are limited to one page (font must be at least 11 point and may not be less than single line spacing).
5. Nominations will be judged on the responses to the criteria. Supporting letters are highly encouraged.
6. Incomplete nominations, or nominations that do not address all of the criteria, will not be considered.
7. Current residency in the Greater Atlanta area is required.
8. Individuals must have been alive on March 6, 2020 to be eligible for nomination for the 2020 awards.
9. Award winners are not eligible to be re-nominated for the same award previously won.
10. Nominations from previous years will be kept on file for reevaluation and consideration.
11. Included in the nomination materials should be an updated CV and head shot.

- b. Description of the nominee's work in encouraging and motivating others to get involved with and/or take leadership roles in philanthropy (i.e. challenge gifts, matching gifts, volunteering, etc.). **(0-20 points)**
- c. Description of the innovation/creativity/leadership in the causes the nominee supported, how issues were addressed or solved and/or how the funds were raised. **(0-20 points)**
