## Guidelines for Submitting Nominations

1. The deadline for nominations for AFP Greater Atlanta Chapter's Awards for National Philanthropy Day is Friday, May 7 at 11:59 p.m. EST. Late entries will not be accepted.
2. All nominations **MUST** be submitted using the forms available on the AFP Greater Atlanta Chapter website and sent via email. Individuals should use the corresponding form for each award category and follow the instructions listed on the form. When the form is complete, please attach your document to an email and send to [jbrown@asginfo.net](mailto:jbrown@asginfo.net).
3. All nominations **MUST** address all of the criteria set out for each award. Narratives should contain complete, clear and concise answers to the criteria. Answers to each question are limited to one page (font must be at least 12 point and must not be less than single line spacing).
4. Nominations will be judged on the responses to the criteria. Supporting letters are strongly encouraged.
5. Incomplete nominations, or nominations that do not address all of the criteria, will not be considered.
6. **Award winners must attend the luncheon on November 4, 2021 and be present to receive the award.** Award winners will be notified in mid-August.
8. Current residency in the Greater Atlanta area is required.
9. Nominees must be 13-19 years of age at the time of the event, November 4, 2021.
10. Award winners are not eligible to be re-nominated for the same award previously won.
11. Nominations from previous years must be re-submitted to be considered.

- b. Description of the impact that was made on the community, including numbers of people involved, financial impact, organizations helped; etc. Please include the names and contact information of individuals at the organizations who benefited from the nominee's work. **(0-30 points)**

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- c. Long term (3-5 years) impact of the nominee's work. Will the project(s) be ongoing and has the nominee considered next steps or is the nominee currently working on other projects?  
**(0-20 points)**
- d. Evidence that the project(s) can serve as a prototype for others or is easily replicable in other communities.  
**(0-10 points)**
