AFP-HAMPTON ROADS 2019 AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING EMERGING PHILANTHROPIC LEADER

This award recognizes an individual 45 years of age or younger for their exceptional generosity and civic responsibility demonstrated through financial contributions and volunteerism to charitable organizations within the Hampton Roads region.

The nominee's personal generosity and community leadership must have motivated others to give and become involved in philanthropy.

The nominee must be no older than 45 years of age on the date of the National Philanthropy Day awards luncheon, November 12, 2019.

Nominations MUST address the following criteria, and consideration will be based solely upon the responses:

- Description of how the nominee has demonstrated his/her exceptional generosity, civic responsibility, and community impact. (0-40 points)
- Examples of the nominee's financial contributions to charitable organizations in the Hampton Roads region. (0-30 points)
- Description of the nominee's volunteer activities and how they have motivated others to become involved in philanthropy. (0-30 points)
