AFP-HAMPTON ROADS 2019 AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING VOLUNTEER FUNDRAISER

This award recognizes a person who provides exceptional leadership in coordinating <u>fundraising</u> projects or activities for a charitable organization or cause, with a preference for community work that has a direct impact on the Hampton Roads region.

The recipient must demonstrate outstanding leadership skills and the ability to motivate volunteers. By generously giving of his/her time and talents, this person makes a measurable impact on philanthropy in the community.

Nominations MUST address the following criteria, and consideration will be based solely upon the response:

 For each organization/cause for which nominee has helped raise funds, provide descriptions of (1) leadership role(s) and Responsibilities; (2) ability to organize and manage campaigns and groups; (3) funds raised; (4) time, effort, and personal financial commitment; and (5) IMPACT the nominee's work had on the organization's ability to provide programs and services. (0-80 points)

- Description of both the nominee's ability to lead, motivate, manage, and inspire others, and their ability to work within a team. (0-10 points)
- Description of the nominee's support of other nonprofits where he/she may have not have led fundraising efforts, but actively served on boards and committees, gave, and volunteered. (0-10 points)
