CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Personal Giving
Board members are expected to make a personal leadership gift to AFP International annual fundraising campaign (currently called Be The Cause Campaign.)
PARTICIPATION
Board members are expected to make it a high priority to attend all meetings of the Board and committees as
well as monthly luncheons. Board members are expected to prepare for board meetings. At a minimum, board
members are expected to attend (or attend via phone) 80% board meetings per year. Board members are also
expected to actively chair or participate in at least one committee. Board members are expected to attend
National Philanthropy Day.
RECRUITMENT
Board members use their personal and business contacts to identify individuals and organizations that are
prospects for membership and sponsorships for the AFP-HR and facilitate the introduction of the AFP-HR to
these donors. They also identify future board members and assist with cultivation of those individuals.
STEWARDSHIP
Board members provide stewardship over the organization's financial matters and have responsibility for
ensuring the AFP's financial strength and vitality. Board members are also privy to information about chapter
members, such as contact information and personal interests. Due to the fact that chapter members entrust us
to be stewards of their information, it is important that all information remains confidential, is not discussed
with others and is not disclosed for any purpose outside of AFP sanctioned use.
SUPPORT OF THE GROUP
Board members are expected to work with and respect the opinions of peers who serve on this Board. Board
members are also expected to positively support internally and externally all actions taken by the Board of
Directors, even if holding a dissenting opinion.
If I do not fulfill my commitments to the organization, I will work with the Board President to address any
concerns. If, for any reason, I find myself unable to carry out the above duties, I agree to resign my position as a
Board member/officer.
