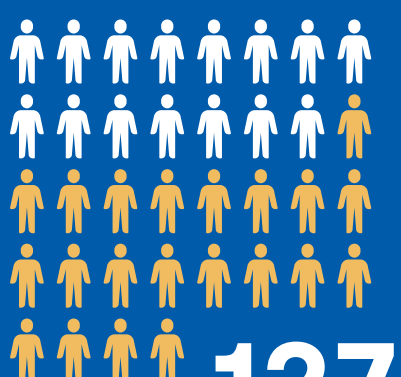




TEN STAR AWARD AFP IDEA CHAMPION
