- Stay informed using our website or QR code.

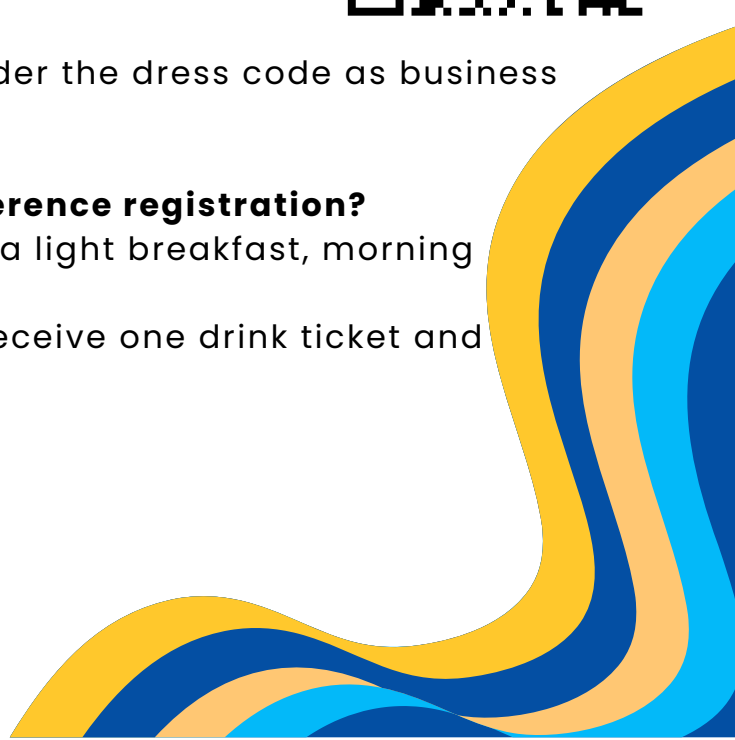


What is the Dress Code?

Will the conference offer a virtual format?

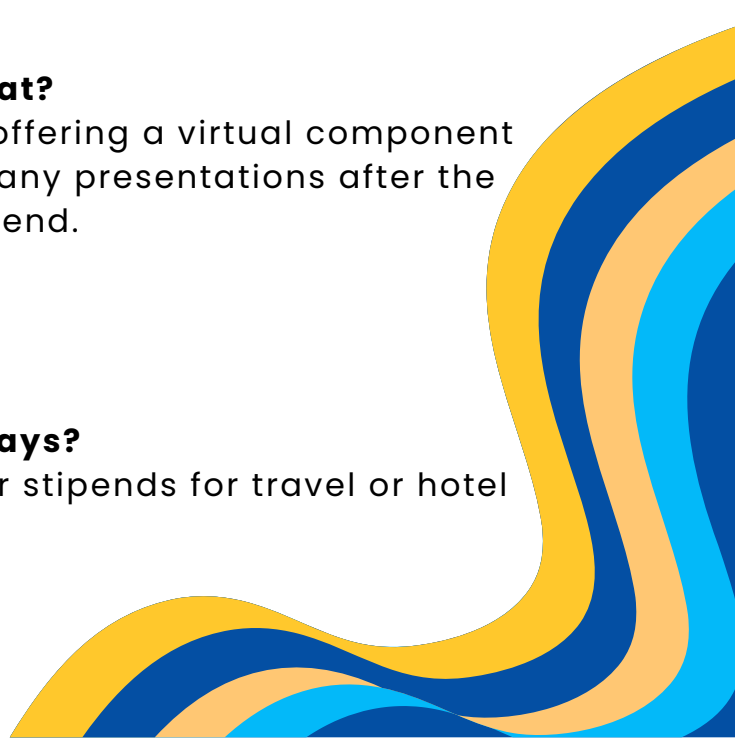
- MFC26 is 100% in person. We are not offering a virtual component this year however we will be sharing any presentations after the conference for those who can not attend.
