

2024 Chamberlain Scholarship AFP ICON 2024 • April 7-9, 2024 – Toronto, Canada

The AFP Foundation for Philanthropy offers every AFP chapter one Chamberlain Scholarship, which covers the recipient's conference registration to the AFP ICON 2024 in Toronto, Canada, on April 7-9, 2024.

The Chamberlain Scholarship program honors <u>Ralph E. Chamberlain, CFRE</u>, who had a long and distinguished career of service to AFP. This program is designed to help individuals serving nonprofit organizations develop their knowledge and skills in fundraising by attending the annual international conference. The program by has the following guidelines:

- The scholarship is available to individuals who have <u>never</u> attended an AFP International conference/ICON.
- The scholarship covers only the full registration fee. Travel and other associated costs with inperson attendance are the responsibility of the recipient. The scholarship will be paid directly to the international conference registration and will <u>not</u> be sent to the scholarship recipient.
- Applicants are asked to wait for the chapter's scholarship committee decision before registering
 for the conference. The recipient is responsible for registering themselves online for the
 conference by using a special discount code that will be provided via email from AFP Global.
 Scholars are responsible for making their own travel and lodging arrangements.
- If the recipient has already registered before they were named a Chamberlain Scholar, they will be required to request a refund in writing (instructions will be provided in the congratulatory email).
- The recipient must agree to share his or her experience at AFP ICON 2024 in a future AFP Aloha Chapter monthly e-newsletter.
- To be fair to all applicants, please be sure that you are available to attend the AFP ICON 2024 and can cover all associated costs prior to submitting your application.

<u>Deadline</u>: Complete the following scholarship application and submit via email or mail (postmarked) no later than 5:00 pm (HST) on or before **Friday**, **January 12**, **2024** to <u>admin@afphawaii.org</u>. Award notification will be made by email on or before Friday, January 19, 2024.

The following criteria will be reviewed and used to select scholarship recipients: 1) Budget size of the applicant's organization; 2) Tax exempt status (i.e. 501(c)3 organization); 3) Applicant's job responsibilities and the percentage of time categorized as "fund development"; 4) Number of times the applicant has previously received an AFP scholarship; 5) Statement of need and how the scholarship will benefit the applicant and the applicant's organization; 6) Multiple applications may be submitted from one employer/agency, however, scholarship amount may be reduced.

Applicants are asked NOT to register/make payment until notification of scholarships are made. All scholarship applicants will be notified via email. Please note that this may be a partial scholarship only (see scholarship cover letter for details).
