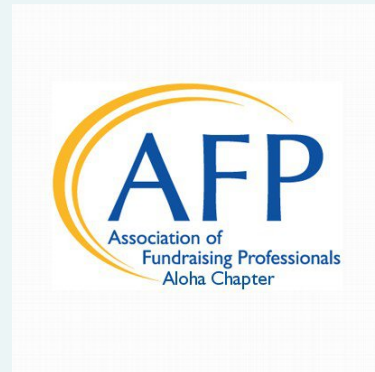

At the 2016 AFP Leadership Academy Chapter President Council meeting in Portland, Tokumura was elected to the AFP Committee on Directorship for a two-year term.

The Committee on Directorship consists of 18 members: the immediate past chair of the Association, who serves as chair; the current chair of the Association; the chair-elect; twelve members elected by each member district elected by the chapter presidents from that district, plus an equal number of alternates (one from each district) who shall serve if any member of the committee resigns; and two members appointed by the chair of the Association. The Association president and CEO is ex-officio as a non-voting member. Aloha Chapter is part of District A, which consists of chapters from California, Nevada and Hawaii.

The Committee on Directorship nominates officers and members of the board of directors; ensures orientation of new board members; and evaluates board members' performance based on criteria. The Committee on Directorship announces a slate of nominees to the full international membership prior to the established date of the fall board meeting, at which time the ratification occurs.
