AWARD CRITERIA

1.	<p>Evidence of what the nominee did, including goals, process, budget and other people involved in the process (adult leaders or adviser) and of the time, talent, and or treasure the youth gave for the common good and the results that were achieved. (0 - 25 points)</p>
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2.	Description of the impact the nominee/project had on the community, including numbers of people involved, organizations helped, etc. Please include the names and contact information of individuals and organizations who benefited from the nominee's work. (0 - 25 points)
3.	Description of long-term (1 -2 years) impact of the nominee's work. Will the project(s) be on-going and has the nominee considered the next step or is working on other projects? (0 - 20 points)
4.	Evidence that the project(s) can serve as a prototype for others or is easily replicable in other communities.. (0 - 20 points)

5.

Evidence of support for implementing creative or innovative approaches to community issues. (0 - 10 points)
