Summary

At Father Joe's Villages, we're looking for compassionate, mission-driven individuals to join our team and help us end homelessness one life at a time. Development Officer, Individual Giving is charged with identifying, cultivating, soliciting and stewarding donors who give \$1,000 - \$5,000 annually. Managing a portfolio of 150 donors, the DO will work to increase the donors support by engaging them in meaningful cultivation and stewardship activities, strengthening their commitment and support of Father Joe's Villages.

Essential Functions

- Manages an active portfolio of 150 existing donors giving \$1,000 \$5,000 annual with an emphasis in growing support by engaging donors with meaningful and thoughtful stewardship.
- Secure funds for the organization by managing a group of assigned, qualified donors assuring that as many as possible are retained as donors and are upgraded in their giving and involvement.
- Under the direction of the Director of Development, create individual goals for each person in assigned portfolio based on the donor's history of giving and the organization's knowledge of that donor's potential.
- Working in collaboration with the events and major gifts teams, conduct monthly Executive tours of Father Joe's Villages' East Village.
- Working in collaboration with the events and major gifts team, assist with donor stewardship events including events held in donor homes, donor luncheons and masses.
- Oversee the development and production of three Impact Reports annually geared toward donors who contribute \$1,000+ annually.
- Meet quarterly goals for donor outreach including personal calls to assigned donors, donor visits and outreach via email and mail



Job Description

- Utilize the Organization's CRM database and other available prospect research and analytical tools to identify, segment, and qualify a broader and deeper pool of prospective donors with the capacity and affinity to make annual gifts at targeted levels
- Work closely with colleagues across the organization implement targeted communications and engagement strategies, stewardship, and tailored events/experiences.
- Manages systems and software to track and cultivate donors and prospects, including our donor database and wealth screening tools.

Job Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree in Communications, Business or English or equivalent.
- At least 3 years of experience in non-profit fundraising with individual donors, corporate partners and/or special events.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills and a proven ability to build strong and authentic personal relationships with people of all backgrounds including those with influence
- Intermediate user of MS Office and donor software (Raisers Edge preferred).
- Be at least 21 years of age with a minimum of 3 years of driving experience; possesses a valid California driver's license; and has no Class 1 or more than two Class 2 violations within the past 36 months.
- Participate in an annual Tuberculosis screening and/or other screenings when necessary. Reasonable accommodations may be granted where appropriate.

Work Environment

 Work is in a controlled environment and involves some exposure to moderate risk of accident.
