This position reports to the Associate Director, Research & Stewardship.

WHAT YOU WILL DO

- Develop and execute stewardship activities for the organization's major donors, demonstrating prudent management of relationships with donors through strategic communication, recognition and events
- Advise, establish and implement a comprehensive stewardship plan and guidelines for all donors, developing subsets for campaign, conservation, endowment, planned giving, and estate donors
- Develop and executive broad stewardship for annual donors and members
- Oversee and manage all aspects of donor plaques, from generating donor listings and plaque creation, to advising of proper placement and overseeing installation, developing a sophisticate system for tracking recognition, ensuring plaque maintenance, and connecting with donors regarding donor recognition updates and inquiries
- Develop, organize and facilitate behind-the-scenes tours of San Diego Zoo and San Diego Zoo Safari Park, and escort tours when needed; develop and maintain appropriate databases and records for department behind-the-scenes tours
- Lead the organization, coordination and facilitation of donor stewarding and acknowledgement events
- Conceptualize, develop and create unique stewardship touches for the Zoo's top donors and prospects
- Produce regular stewardship reports that show donors how their gifts are being used and the impact of their generosity
- Devise and execute donor stewardship mailings, including campaign progress updates, annual report mailings, seasonal appreciation touches and fulfillment of promised benefits
- Manage acknowledgement and recognition of campaign giving and endowed funds, including letters, events, plaques and custom recognition activities and gifts
