The role requires strong relationship-building skills, strategic thinking, and the ability to represent the university with professionalism and enthusiasm.

As a member of the Institutional Advancement team, the Director of Leadership Giving will be responsible for the following:

Identify, cultivate, secure and steward gifts of \$15,000 to \$25,000 and above. Determine donor capacity to make leadership-level gifts by conducting discovery visits and cultivating new prospects.

Prepare and execute personalized stewardship plans for major donors, including multiple touchpoints throughout the year to ensure long-term retention.

Identify corporations and businesses to establish collaborative partnerships that align institutional needs with funding interests - specifically, securing corporate sponsorships for the Daemen University Gala.

Cultivate new funding sources to enhance scholarship opportunities.

Manage the annual Scholarship Brunch event, including outreach, cultivation and stewardship efforts for donors and scholarship recipients.

Drive campaign efforts and strategies that advance the mission of Daemen University and promote a comprehensive understanding of our philanthropic priorities among internal and external stakeholders.

Participate in alumni, donors, and other advancement and campus events and programs as needed.

Work in coordination with our advancement services team to record activity of prospects into the CRM database in a timely manner.
