UNLOCKING THE KEY TO FUNDING SUCCESS: Secrets to Building Lasting Relationships with Grant Funders

In the film "The Pursuit of Happyness" (2006), Chris Gardner (Will Smith) strives for a stockbroking internship. In one scene, Chris is given a crucial opportunity to impress the hiring managers during a job interview. Chris is overlooked despite his solid plan, emphasizing the need to establish personal connections alongside a strong proposal.

As a foundation relations manager, I had a similar experience. I prepared a compelling proposal but understood the significance of building a meaningful relationship. I engaged the funder in conversation, learning about their interests and values. I demonstrated my organization's commitment to collaboration and long-term impact.

Can you tell what was different about Chris' approach and my approach? His lack of rapport and personal engagement with the panel is evident, resulting in an unsuccessful pitch. His approach was almost purely transactional. To build strong relationships with grant funders, consider these seven secrets:
