I've been in fundraising for over 35 years and I've lived through other times of uncertainty, but I'm not sure if I've seen anything compared to this in the terms of the impact that it's having on every facet of life! That said, I do believe in the good will of people. Even when times are tough, there are people who are willing to give back to help others. I do feel like philanthropy will continue, and this will certainly require some innovation on our end, but I do think that people want to help when there are obvious priorities for their resources and when they know that they are needed to make a difference. We need to keep a positive attitude that people will step up and we need to continue to ask!
