Transformational Capacity Building



Capacity building for a nonprofit is the process of building and strengthening systems, structures, cultures, skills, resources and power that organizations need to serve their communities. In a new piece published in the Stanford Social Innovation Review, leaders from RVC,

April Nishimura, Roshni Sampath, Anbar Mahar Sheikh and Ananda Valenzuela, along with philanthropy leader, Vu Le, share how conventional approaches to capacity building have been inaccessible and often unsuccessful for nonprofits led by and serving communities of color. The authors offer seven approaches that have emerged from their work in these communities to improve capacity for organizations serving and led by BIPOC.


