September Nonprofit Jobs Report

The National Council of Nonprofits relays the news that national nonprofit employment fell by 2,500 jobs in September, registering a decline of nearly 560,000 nonprofit jobs since the onset of the pandemic, according the latest report from the Center for Civil Society Studies at Johns Hopkins



University. Increased employment in social assistance (12,000) and arts (6,600) were more than cancelled out by job losses in education (13,000) and healthcare (7,600). September's jobs numbers reflect the sector's first monthly decline since December 2020, showing we still have a long way to go to recover all the nonprofit jobs lost because of the pandemic.
