### Temple Grandin: RMPI's Featured Speaker

The world is changing and so is philanthropy – in many ways for the better. This fall at Rocky Mountain Philanthropy Institute (RMPI), AFP Colorado will bring together over 150 nonprofit professionals to push us to think even more differently about the purpose of our work and the possibilities ahead.



Helping to facilitate this will be featured speaker *Dr. Temple Grandin*. As a world-renowned expert on applying different thinking styles to the livestock industry and a person with autism, Dr. Grandin will challenge you to reframe your perceptions and develop creative solutions for your organization.

Dr. Grandin was named a "Hero" among Time's 100 most influential people in the world, was the subject of an Emmy- and Golden Globewinning film (Temple Grandin), and has been an outspoken proponent of the autism rights and neurodiversity movements. Her 2010 TED talk, "The World Needs All Kinds of Minds", has been viewed by over 6,000,000 people, and her influence extends into books, lectures, and more.

When you attend virtual RMPI this September 9th and 10th, you'll have the chance to engage with Dr. Grandin, as well as keynote speaker *Edgar Villanueva*, local experts, and of course many nonprofit peers from across Colorado.

Early-bird registration for RMPI opens in early May, so keep an eye on your email, and be sure to save September 9th and 10th!
