Scam Scum

Westword has as an extensive article about the alleged fraud conducted by Travis Singhaus. Singhaus was arrested on January 9 and charged with theft, forgery, three counts of charitable fraud, and three counts of criminal impersonation. He had claimed to run a charity called Impact



Network but it looks like he defrauded donors of at least \$350,000.

The Denver District Attorney's Office reminds everyone that before giving to any organization, it is wise to check the charity's state and federal standing per the below links.

IRS Charities and Nonprofits search site lists registered charities, and if they are approved for 501(c)(3) or other statuses.

Colorado Secretary of State's Charities and Fundraisers search site lists charities registered with Colorado, and their donation fund's usage breakdown.

Singhaus, however, allegedly used the EIN of another organization with the same name. The Impact Network website is still up; you can investigate yourself how professionally it was done. It is really difficult for donors to protect themselves from scam artists with extensive criminal energy.
