Understanding Sex Worker Led Movements



The National Committee for Responsive Philanthropy (NCRP) released a publication featuring stories of sex worker led movements. As so often in history, marginalized groups question the status quo and provide valid and valuable suggestions that will improve society overall. For example, the 4 lessons from sex worker giving circles are:

- Provide unrestricted general operating grantmaking dollars and multiyear commitments whenever possible.
- Center trauma-informed approaches to grantmaking.
- Embrace and systematize language justice as core to our values

• Stop imposing unnecessary and harmful bureaucratic challenges on groups on the ground.

In local news, the Colorado legislature is deliberating on a bill to ensure a way for sex workers to safely report assault by providing immunity from prosecution for the offense of prostitution. Victims of assault and rape provided harrowing testimony in the first committee session.
