Thousands of nonprofit organizations across the country have made statements over the past month in response to the murder of George Floyd, and other unarmed black men and women. Organizations are acknowledging the existence of systemic racism and inequality in this country more than ever before. How will nonprofits live these values?



"Statements are external," shares Kerrien Suarez, executive director of Equity in the Center, "...what will they do in the days ahead to live into those values? Because as of today, the overwhelming majority of organizations that released statements with those words in it do not have a culture where the black people who work there feel that they are valued as equal to white people."
