



Jodeen (she/ella) has served in executive leadership roles across the philanthropic, private, and nonprofit sectors and has over 20 years of experience leading cross-sector initiatives for a more inclusive democracy and an economic system rooted in racial and gender equity.

With over a decade of senior leadership in philanthropy, Jodeen has been recognized for significantly shifting and scaling funding to racial and gender equity organizations; has led fund development and donor education for multiple equity-focused funds; and piloted program and mission investing strategies for endowed philanthropies.

Jodeen's leadership as a board member and trustee includes serving as board president for the Movement Voter Fund, Poder Latinx, the Chicana Empowerment Fund, the Inclusive Democracy and Climate Equity Fund, and the Movement Strategy Center. She has also served on the boards for the Working Families Party National Committee; GALvanize USA, the National Institute for Money in Politics, the southwest Abortion Fund and the YWCA of Boulder County. Her experience also includes sitting on the advisory boards of several impact investing ventures that invest in women and people of color led social enterprises.

Her senior leadership in power-building organizations includes Campaign Director for the National Domestic Workers' Alliance and Caring Across Generations; elected leadership to the Working Families Party National Committee; Vice President at a racial justice public policy institution; and Field Director for MoveOn.
