Section Head Sample: This \LaTeX document is set up with the correct formatting. The primary header (sections) use the following format: upper and lower case, bold, followed by a colon.

Level-two section head... should be lower case and in italics. The paper format is set to U.S. letter, 8.5" x 11", page margins are one inch on all sides. Text is in two even columns with alignment set to Justify. Fonts are set to Times New Roman size 10pt. Automatic paragraph indents of 0.25 inches are imbedded to appear every time you use a hard return.

Figures: Include up to one figure or table. A figure can be included within the columns, as follows:



Figure 1: A column-width figure can fit on the page. Use linewidth for the width to span the column.

However, full-width figures will end up on the second page (see next page). If this is the case, keep the caption to a minimum. Make sure to use the figure* [!h] command so the figure is placed.

Tables. Tables can be placed similar to figures, using & to mark out the columns. A convenient way to generate \LaTeX tables is www.tablesgenerator.com.

If you are including tables or figures, they must be imported into this file as you will not be able to upload any additional documents with your abstract. All image formats are acceptable but figures should be kept to as small as possible to reduce the overall file size. There is no specific word count limit for the abstract but the total length should not exceed 1 page, single sided, unless a single full-width figure or table is included, which will be generated on the second page.

In-text citations: \LaTeX handles the proper format for citations. For textual citations, use Meadows et al. (2018). For parenthetical citations, use (Jeans, 1921).
