[Abstract submission is now open](#) for [AGU25](#), happening 15- 19 December in New Orleans, Louisiana. This year we have 34 different EPSP sessions planned, covering the broad range of science we do in our Section. **Abstract submissions are due on or before 30 July at 23:59 Eastern.**

Other important dates to keep in mind leading up to AGU25:

- Late August - Registration opens
- Early October - Full scientific schedule posted and abstract acceptance notices go out
- Early November - Last chance for early-bird (discounted) registration
