AGU23 Updates

AGU23 registration and housing are now open, you can <u>register here</u> (make sure to register by 2 November to take advantage of discounted rates. Additionally, for the first time since 2019, AGU Child Care will be back this year. Many of the official AGU Housing options go quickly; however, even if a hotel is listed as sold out in the official AGU housing portal, AGU staff may still be able to help you secure a room. While you're registering for AGU23 attendance, there are two additional EPSP events you can sign up for. First, please **sign up for the (FREE) EPSP Reception and Section Gathering on Tuesday night (12 December)**. Signing up for this event helps us get an accurate headcount and assures that there will be enough food and drink to go around. Second, and new this year, **we're hosting an EPSP Student and Early Career Celebration on the Monday night of AGU23 (11 December) at 6:30 PM**. This event will offer early career members a chance to get advice from and socialize with some of our recent EPSP Award winners and AGU Fellows. Light refreshments will be provided, tickets required (\$5 for students, \$15 for non-students). You can sign up for this event (limited to 50 people) when registering for the meeting. Note that this is separate from the informal early career event that members of the student committee typically host.
