Tagging your discussion posts or library entries may aid in helping people find information on the site.


- You don't need to use a hashtag in the search bar, you can search any word or term. Using a hashtag will pull things that are specifically marked with that hashtag.





PRE members to post announcements, share resources, ask questions and receive comments.

When creating a discussion post or library entry, If you type the # symbol in the description area, a list of possible hashtags should show up.



You can also type a #word and then a list of similar hashtags should appear if they exist – or you can create a new one.



If you create an entry and then remember that you want to add a hashtag, you can do it after the fact.
