## I. What We Do

AHEAD supports government policies that ensure full and effective participation by individuals with disabilities in every aspect of the postsecondary experience. This includes:

- Rights and protections Government policies that protect the rights of students with disabilities and other minority groups
- **Diversity, Equity, Respect, and Inclusivity** Government policies that promote diversity, equality, respect, and inclusivity in higher education for students with disabilities



- National Center for College Students with Disabilities (NCCSD)
- College financial aid flexibility for college students with disabilities
- Respond, Innovate, Succeed, and Empower (RISE) Act
- Improved Access to Technology Accommodations
- Better Data/Information



### National Center for College Students with Disabilities (NCCSD)

- Rep. Alma Adams (D-NC) and Sen. Tammy Duckworth (D-IL) letters
- \$2 million would have been in FY25 federal funding bill
- Met with Congressional appropriations staff
- New spending bucket
- Reached out to the US Department of Education
- FY26



### **College financial aid flexibility**

#### **House bill**

- Rep. Joe Morelle (D-NY)
- Pell Grant only
- 9 cosponsors (6 Democrats/3 Republicans)
- Reintroduced this April by Rep. Morelle and Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick (R-PA)

#### Senate bill

- Sen. Bob Casey (D-PA)
- Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant
- Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) grant programs
- 3 cosponsors (Sen. Chris Van Hollen (D-MD), Sen. Cory Booker (D-NJ), and Sen. Bernie Sanders (I-VT)
- Sen. Van Hollen is working to reintroduce



### Respond, Innovate, Succeed, and Empower (RISE) Act

- Over half the cosponsors
- Meetings with House and Senate senior staff and sponsors
- Raised our concerns
- Endorsed
- Been reintroduced in the House
- Rep. Suzanne Bonamici (D-OR)
- Sen. Maggie Hassan (D-NH) & Sen. Bill Cassidy (R-LA)
