We received internal system recognition "Baptist Excels" for our reduction in contrast extravasations over the past 4 years due to improvements in our processes. We also are part of an internal system resource council that involves routine meetings with imaging leaders across our system to share ideas, reduce variation and collaborate on purchases and technology. We have imaging navigators in our department that have helped reduce turnaround times for follow up care for mammography screening, lung screening, and incidental finding patients in order to get a diagnosis faster.</p>
