Cultural Sensitivity Items to keep in mind while in Italy:

Body language is an important part of the Italian way of communicating. Don't be scared of people gesticulating while talking to you. Pay attention to what it conveys.

Italians are not familiar with the concept of personal space. You'll find somebody that will take initiative and hug and kiss you. Don't be scared by that (see body language above). However, don't hug and kiss everyone: nobody will be offended if you do so, but not all Italians are as expansive as you may think.

Not all Italians are fully fluent in English and capable of catching up with any English accent. Try to slow down a bit if you get the impression that the person you are talking to does not understand.

Humor is very well received in the course of business discussions. However, keep in mind that jokes about Italian criminal organizations (which appear common among non-Italian people) might not be necessarily well received by Italians.



Cultural sensitivity items to keep in mind while in London:

- Don't hug everyone;
- The British are generally not as direct as Americans. Americans can come across as aggressive, when you thought you were merely being helpfully direct;
- Don't assume all British English words and phrases mean the same as words and phrases from the USA. Many of British English words and phrases have different or even opposite meanings!
- Humour is often an important part of business discussions, and having a repertoire of jokes and anecdotes can be an asset. Moreover, people who are good at telling jokes and stories should make the most of these abilities. Characteristics of British humour include not stating the obvious, as well as implying the opposite of what is being said. Consequently, paying attention to what is not said or done is often a necessary part of appreciating this style of humour. Be warned: the English can use humour, especially irony or sarcasm, as a weapon in ridiculing an adversary or showing disagreement or even contempt;
- To link the last two points together – simply tell everyone you meet that you are wearing your warm pants because it is so cold in the UK and you will be guaranteed to get a laugh.
