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

EXHIBITOR HOUSING

Limited Housing has been reserved at the Hyatt Regency Huntington Beach, CA. A link to the AGS housing block will be made available to exhibitors on November 15, 2024.

EXHIBIT SETUP

The AGS exhibit hall is designed for 10' x10' booth spaces, 10' x 5' booth spaces or combinations of adjacent booths of that size. You may not bring exhibits that are larger than your allotted space. Bulky items can be intrusive to other exhibitors by blocking or impeding attendees from getting to other exhibit booths. If a large item that is critical to your exhibit will not fit in your booth space, you must contact the AGS prior to the meeting so proper placement on the exhibit floor can be assessed. You may be required to rent a second space to accommodate the item. Items not cleared with the AGS before arrival may not be set up. You may choose your exhibit space by selecting up to 3 preferred locations on the provided floor plan. Once registration opens, the floor plan will be updated daily to reflect available space. You will be placed in your top pick based on a first come, first served basis. We will do our absolute best to accommodate your requests, but your exhibit space is subject to change. The AGS reserves the right to accept or reject, in its sole discretion, any request to exhibit, and to determine the eligibility of any proposed exhibits.

ACCME GUIDELINES

No commercial promotional materials shall be displayed or distributed in the educational space before, during, or after a CME activity. Representatives of commercial supporters may not engage in sales activities while in the room where educational activity takes place. Support of AGS CME activities does not influence AGS booth space assignment decisions.

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SHIPPING, HANDLING AND STORAGE
