

The portal for submitting invited session proposals for JSM 2023 is now open! The submission site will be open through **Thursday, September 8, 2022 (11:59 p.m. Eastern, 8:59 p.m. Pacific)**, for session proposals. Visit the submission site at [2023 Joint Statistical Meetings - One Community: Informing Decisions and Driving Discovery - Toronto, Ontario, Canada \(amstat.org\)](https://www.amstat.org/meetings/ism/2023/guidelines.cfm) to submit a proposal for next year's JSM.

Few items for your consideration:

- The theme for JSM 2023 is "One Community: Informing Decisions and Driving Discovery," but not all sessions have to adhere to this theme.
- Formats vary for invited sessions; however, all are 110 minutes in length and have a session chair. The sessions typically include 2–6 participants, including the chair, with two of the most popular and successful formats being 2–3 speakers with a discussant or a panel discussion of 3–5 panelists.
- Please contact potential participants before submitting a proposal, as they already may have committed to participating in another session at JSM 2023. There are participation guidelines and restrictions regarding the number of times and in what capacity one can participate in the program: <https://www.amstat.org/meetings/ism/2023/guidelines.cfm>.
- Organizers are able to select up to three (3) potential sponsors for their proposal submissions.

Detailed information needed to submit an invited session proposal is provided below. If you encounter any problems with the online system, please contact Naomi Friedman at naomi@amstat.org. You will need to have the following information to submit your session proposal online:

1. Session Type (Invited Paper or Invited Panel)
2. Sponsor (Outside Organization, ASA Committee, ASA Section, Sponsoring Society, ASA Journal). A pre-approved list is provided; select no more than three.
3. Session Title
4. Session Description - Please provide a short description of the session, including focus, content, timeliness, appeal and format of the session.
5. Session organizer, including affiliation and email address
6. Session chair, including affiliation and email address
7. Session speakers and any discussants, including affiliation and email address
