MORE ON GLOBAL ETHICS DAY

As background, Global Ethics Day takes place on the third Wednesday in October. This year, the theme is #EthicsReenvisioned. The event is hosted by the <u>Carnegie Council for Ethics in International Affairs</u>. It encourages individuals and organizations worldwide to engage with ethical issues and activate their communities for a more just and peaceful world. General <u>Activities</u> are suggested for group and individual participation by the Carnegie Council for Ethics in International Affairs.

This year, the ASA Committee on Professional Ethics decided to use this day to get our members and beyond engaged in meaningful activities regarding ethics in the professions of statistics and data science. #8: HOST A LUNCH & LEARN DISCUSSION OR SEMINAR

OPTION 1: CHECK OUT THE DISCUSSION GUIDE IN THE TOOLKIT. ITS ALREADY PLANNED FOR YOU!

OPTION 2: INVITE YOUR ETHICS OFFICER OR A GUEST SPEAKER TO YOUR GROUP OR CLASS. PLAN TIME FOR Q&A AND DISCUSSION. WE INCLUDED A SAMPLE INVITATION AS A MODEL IN THE TOOLKIT.

OPTION 3: HAVE YOUR GROUP READ AN ARTICLE AND JOIN A VIRTUAL OR IN-PERSON BROWN BAG. WE HAVE A LIST OF SUGGESTED ARTICLES IN THE TOOLKIT OR CHOOSE YOUR OWN.

#7: EXPLORE AN EXISTING ETHICS CASE SCENARIO

WE'VE PROVIDED YOU A LIST OF LINKS TO ETHICS CASE STUDIES IN THE TOOLKIT. SOME EVEN PROVIDE DISCUSSION GUIDES.

Wait! You don't see one that resonates with your audience or captures a common scenario for your group. Don't worry. See #4 with easy instructions on how to create your own.

#6 ORGANIZE OR JOIN AN ETHICS MEET-UP

- ISOLATED STATISTICIAN OR DATA SCIENTIST?

 This one is for you. You can do it virtually or through your local ASA Chapter.
- LEADER OR MEMBER OF A CHAPTER?

 You could organize one or even a few of these if your chapter is spread out.

ASA SECTIONS OR A GROUP THAT SPREAD ACROSS THE MILES (OR KILOMETERS)?

Plan an online meet-up.

Our Meet-ups Planning Guides give ideas on what you could do at the meetup for any of these situations.

#5: HOST A SMALL GROUP OR CLASS DISCUSSION

GO FORMAL BY USING THE ARTICLE DISCUSSION GUIDE IN THE TOOLKIT.

This one includes links to articles, brief overviews, and discussion questions.

- GO INFORMAL AND MAKE THIS DISCUSSION PARTICIPANT LED.

 Give the group an opportunity to submit prompts or topics for discussion. Let them choose an activity.
- IT'S IN THE TOOLKIT

There are several ideas in the toolkit from proposing ethical questions and getting group input to creating a list of common ethical issues and how to respond. There are games like a digital ethics scavenger hunt or brainstorming via "Yes, and ...".

#4: CREATE AND DISCUSS A CUSTOMIZED ETHICS SCENARIO

WHILE YOU MAY BE SKEPTICAL, LLMS ARE A GREAT HELPER IN THIS AREA. USE THE TOOLS!

LLMS write realistic case studies tailored to any level audience.

IT'S IN THE TOOLKIT

We have created a prompt template with examples for you to fill in key information to customize a case study based on audience, area of application, and specific settings.

#3: GIVE A SHORT PRESENTATION ON THE ASA GUIDELINES

- WAIT! WHAT? YOU DON'T HAVE A PRESENTATION READY TO GO ON THE ASA GUIDELINES. THAT'S OKAY. WE HAVE A FEW YOU CAN STEAL, ETHICALLY:). USE THE ENTIRE PRESENTATION OR JUST A FEW SLIDES.
- YOU CAN PICK A PRINCIPLE FROM THE GUIDELINES AND GIVE EXAMPLES OF HOW A FEW OF THE ELEMENTS COULD BE UPHELD OR VIOLATED. GET CREATIVE!

#2: PUBLISH A THOUGHT PIECE ON SOCIAL MEDIA OR A BLOG ENTRY.

- YOU COULD DRAW FROM REAL WORLD EXPERIENCE OR SOMETHING YOU SEE IN THE MEDIA. WE HAVE A LIST OF EXAMPLES WITH LINKS AND A GUIDE FOR WRITING YOUR PIECE.
- ETHICAL GUIDELINES DO COVER HOW TO HANDLE MISCONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS. CLEANSE THE DETAILS APPROPRIATELY WITHOUT WATERING DOWN YOUR KEY POINTS. MORE ON THIS IN THE TOOLKIT.

#1: COMPLETE THE ASA ETHICAL GUIDELINES REVISION SURVEY

- THE THEME OF GLOBAL ETHICS DAY IS ETHICS RE-ENVISIONED! YOU CAN HELP ASA COPE RE-ENVISION ETHICS. WHILE CORE ETHICAL PRINCIPLES REMAIN THE SAME, THE SCENARIOS TO WHICH WE APPLY ETHICS ARE UNDERGOING CONSTANT EVOLUTION (E.G. ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE). THE ASA ETHICAL GUIDELINES WILL CONTINUE TO EVOLVE AS APPLICATIONS EVOLVE.
- REVIEW THE CURRENT GUIDELINES: ASA ETHICAL GUIDELINES
