

BYLAWS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN STATISTICAL ASSOCIATION

SECTION 1. DUES. Dues shall be \$5.00 per annum for Regular Members and \$3.00 per annum for Associate Members. Student member dues shall be \$2.00 per annum.

SECTION 2. NOMINATION OF OFFICERS, AND MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD.
Each year the President shall appoint a committee of three persons to nominate candidates for officers and board members. Ordinarily, the nominee for President will be the current Vice-President, .

SECTION 3. DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY AND TREASURER. The Secretary shall maintain a mailing list of Members, shall send notices of meetings, and shall keep a permanent record of: minutes of the annual meetings, speakers and topics of meetings, Officers, and Executive Board members. The Treasurer shall perform the usual duties of financial officer and shall keep a record of chapter business:

SECTION 4. MINUTES OF MEETING. At the annual meeting, the minutes of the preceding annual business meeting and of any business meeting since the preceding annual meeting shall be read. Minutes reporting programs will not be read unless requested.

SECTION 5. COMMITTEES. The President shall appoint such committees, from time to time, as appropriate for carrying out the functions of the Chapter. Among such committees shall be a Committee on Prizes and Awards, to administer any prizes and awards that may be authorized by, and in the amounts specified by, the Executive Board.

SECTION 6. AUDITING OF FINANCIAL RECORDS. The President shall each year appoint an Auditing Committee to audit the books of the Treasurer.


SECTION 7. ASA COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE. The Chapter representative to the American Statistical Association Council will be appointed by the President of the Chapter at the time when the three year rotation expires or the Chapter representative is unable to complete the three year appointment.

SECTION 8. CHANGES IN BYLAWS. Bylaws may be changed by majority vote at any annual meeting, in accordance with the restrictions and procedure set forth in Article IX of the Constitution for amendment of the Constitution.
