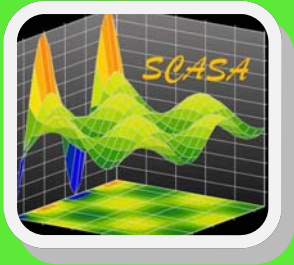

**Course Overview:** Clinical Data Interchange Standards Consortium (CDISC) is a non-profit organization that has established standards to support the acquisition, exchange, submission and archive of clinical research data. The primary objective of this course is to provide the skills and tools necessary to apply the CDISC standards when processing clinical data used for FDA submissions. Specifically, this course will focus on mapping raw datasets to CDISC's Study Data Tabulation Models (SDTM) and Analysis Dataset Models (ADaM). CDISC is an important system to learn because it becomes a requirement in 2014 for selected clinical studies.

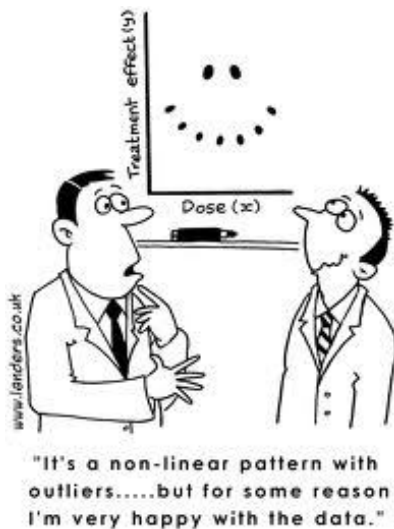

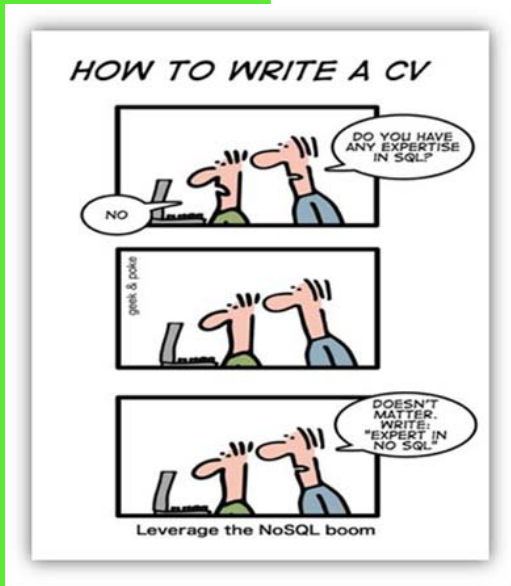
