Opportunity to Organize a Topic-Contributed Section on Statistics and Data Science Education at JSM 2026 in Boston, MA

Hello Statistics Educators,

The ASA Section on Statistics and Data Science Education is seeking topic-contributed session proposals for the 2026 Joint Statistical Meetings in Boston, MA. Proposals must be submitted through the <u>online portal</u> by **Wednesday, December 10, 2025 (11:59 p.m. ET / 8:59 p.m. PT).** A <u>topic-contributed session</u> is organized around a common theme and includes speakers presenting on that shared topic. Talk to potential presenters early, each person may serve as a presenting author in only one session. Please review <u>the JSM 2026 Participation Guidelines</u> for limits on participation.

Types of Topic-Contributed Sessions

- Paper Sessions: Five speakers (at least 3 presenters and up to 2 discussants); 20 minutes per speaker.
- Panels: Three to six panelists offering perspectives on a common topic; no individual abstracts.
- Poster Sessions: 10–15 presenters with posters on a shared theme.

How to Propose a Session

- Develop your topic and a list of speakers who agree to participate.
- Submit your proposal online between November 13 and December 10, 2025.
- Await approval from the JSM Program Committee.
- Ensure all speakers submit abstracts by February 2, 2026 (notifications sent in early January).
- All speakers must register for JSM.

Information Required for Submission

- Session type (Paper or Panel)
- Sponsor (select up to three)
- Session title
- Session description (max 3,500 characters) including:
- Session focus, content, timeliness, and appeal
- Invited speakers/panelists and tentative titles
- Session format (e.g., chair, speakers, discussant)
- Organizer(s), chair, speakers, and/or discussants with affiliations and emails

Paper sessions must have five speakers; panel sessions must have three to six panelists.
