Jennifer Busch, MSN, FNP-BC, RN, NI-BC



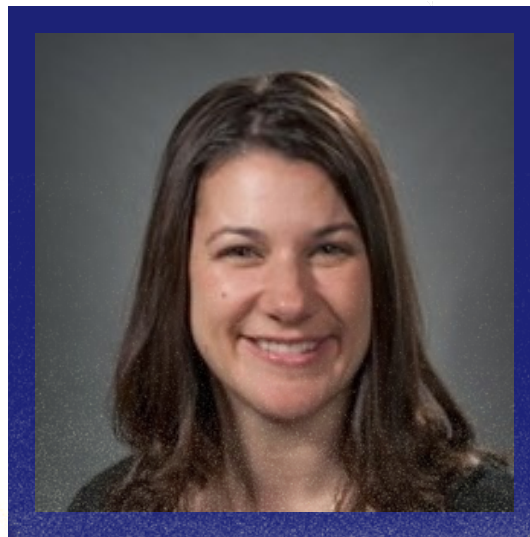

After graduating, Jennifer transitioned into an informatics role and quickly developed a deep passion for improving healthcare through technology and data.

To expand her expertise, Jennifer attended workshops and conferences with leaders in nursing informatics, including Dr. Susan Newbold. These experiences not only strengthened her knowledge but also helped her prepare for and achieve her American Nurses Credentialing Center Certification in Nursing Informatics. It was during these professional conferences that Jennifer first connected with the American Nursing Informatics Association (ANIA) community.

Recognizing ANIA as a natural next step in her professional development, Jennifer joined the organization and soon became involved with the ANIA NY Tri-State Educational Taskforce. Through this involvement, she has built meaningful professional relationships, collaborated with colleagues across healthcare organizations, and continued to strengthen her informatics competencies.

Looking ahead, Jennifer is excited to take on new clinical challenges in the ambulatory care setting and to support her organization's transition from Allscripts to Epic. With her background in nursing informatics, she hopes to help her colleagues navigate the electronic medical record transition while continuing to contribute to process improvement and data-driven initiatives.

She plans to stay actively involved in ANIA and continue contributing to the ANIA NY Tri-State Educational Taskforce, supporting educational events and mentoring future informatics nurses.
