Overview


The APGA Benchmarking Tool allows users to compare their system with averages for other systems or self-defined sub-groups on more than 60 different operational statistics such as number of services by company type or state, leaks per mile of main by cause and damages per excavation ticket. Data for the benchmarks comes from PHMSA Distribution Annual Reports (Form 7100.1-1) Energy Information Administration (EIA) Form 176 and APGA surveys.



Getting Started

Open your internet browser and log on at: http://



The **Header**, **Menu** and **Footer** will appear on every screen. The contents of the **Menu** may change depending on which screen is displayed.



Enter your user name and password, then a screen like this *may* appear:




Whenever there are new or important **Announcements**, they will be shown once you login.

<u>Contact Support:</u> If at any time you encounter problems using the APGA

or have questions not answered in this user's guide, click "APGA Benchmarking 2 Help" and then "Contact Support" in the **Menu**.



This will open a screen in which you should describe the problem encountered. When you click "Submit," an email message to the APGA help desk.



When you use "Contact Support," the APGA Benchmarking Tool automatically includes information about where you are in the program that assists our help desk to pinpoint the source of your problems or questions.

NOTE: The telephone number shown on the the APGA Benchmarking
Tool screens (Contact Us) is for administrative support only (e.g. forgot your password or user name). It is not for technical support.

After reviewing any announcements, click "Next" to continue. A screen like this will appear.





Choose Your System


All of the systems associated with your user name will be displayed. There will be an entry in the list for each year in which data is available for your system(s).

When you log in, the APGA Benchmarking Tool recognizes your system(s) and only allows you to compare your system(s) with peers. If for some reason you need to see a different system for comparison, contact APGA.

Choose the year and system for which you wish to see results by clicking the "View" next that that entry in the list.

Results

The results comparing your current system against all of the available data will appear.



At the top, a summary of the data is shown. This includes the section "Active Filters" that will be described in the next section. Please note that the above show only partial results. There are more than 100 benchmarks actually calculated.



Below these are the results. The first columns describe the particular data being compared.

The column "Peer Group" shows the appropriate totals, averages or percentages for all the other **Benchmarking Tool** data (in addition to your own) against which your data is being compared. This is the "Peer Data."

The "System" column shows the same data for your system.

The "Difference" column shows the percent difference between your data and the peer data. This is calculated by the following equation:

Difference = (Your data – Peer data) / Peer data

Filtering Peer Data

Filters may be used to "drill down" into the peer data, comparing your system against a more specialized set of peer data. By default, you may filter the peer data in the following ways:

Default Filters:

- Data Year
- State of Operation
- System Type (e.g. Investor-owned, Municipal or Privately-owned)
- Miles of Mains (within a user-specified range)
- Number of Services (within a user-specified range)

When you first go to the Benchmarking page, the Data Year is determined by your choice of system and all other filters are set to those chosen when you last used the APGA Benchmarking Tool. To change the filters, click the "*Change*" button next to "Click here to change filter settings."


In order to protect the confidentiality of individual **Benchmarking Tool** user data, you will see no results if your filter(s) result in fewer than three systems in the peer group.

The **available filters**, along with any settings you may have made, are listed in the lower portion of the screen. This is the portion below the "Note: Any filters ..." message.

To add States or System Types to the filters, click the desired item(s) in the left column. It will move to the right column. Items in the right column will be used to filter the data. Clicking an item in the right column will remove it from the filters. This method should be used for any filter presented in a similar "left" "->" "right" list.

For Miles of Mains or Number of Services (or any other numeric filter), you may choose a minimum value to consider (the left hand field) or a maximum value (the right hand field) or both. If you leave a field blank it will not be applied as a filter.

When you have the filters set as you wish, click the "*Update Results*" button. **APGA Benchmarking Tool** will display the benchmarking using those filters.

If you click the "Cancel Changes" button, any changes you may have made to the filter settings will be discarded and the prior results will be displayed.

If you want to remove a filter setting, either clear the field or move all items from a right hand column to the left column.

If you want to remove all the filter settings, click the "Clear All" button.


Note that the filter settings will be remembered from one login to another.

Extra Filters:

In addition to the Default Filters, there are many more filters you may add in the "*Extra Filters*" area. Click in the list on the left to add extra filters. Click in the list on the right to remove extra filters.



Here are the benchmarking results with the filters shown above.



Note that the filters chosen are summarized in the "Active Filters" area and that the Peer Group size has been reduced from more than 1500 systems to only 5 systems.

Downloading Results

When you have the results as you would like, you may click the "*CSV*" button to download a file of this data compatible with Microsoft™ Excel.
