Supplies: • 3M sticky cork board (18x22") • Wall friendly command strips for mounting • Graphics – suns (happy faces), denim pockets labeled with each infection category, shadow figures, numbers All laminated and cut and assembled • Background colored paper • Velcro tabs so that numbers can be easily changed out. Could also use dry-erase on laminated pockets. Student volunteers cut all pieces and assembled board.
