Last Call to Recertify!

The final deadline is quickly approaching for recertification. Remember – chapter activities count towards infection prevention units (IPUs!)

CBIC is **extending** the recertification via IPU portfolio submission deadline to December 8th with no late fees. If the portfolio is not submitted by **December 8th**, the only method to obtain recertification for candidates who miss the **December 8th** deadline is to purchase and complete the initial proctored examination by **December 31**.

For CIC® holders recertifying through the internet-based exam, <u>you must purchase</u> the exam by November 30, 2025 and pass it by December 31, at 11:59 PM GMT (6:59 PM EST).

If you hold the a-IPC™ certification, you only need 5 IPUs to maintain your certification!
