2023 Chapter Survey Deadline Extended

The Annual Chapter Leader Survey is a tool we heavily rely on to gather insights from chapter leaders on your leadership experiences, as well as your challenges and needs in the ongoing management of your local chapters. We also seek feedback regarding your satisfaction with existing leadership resources and how we can better support you and your chapters in the year(s) to come. In addition to informing APIC's development of chapter content and programming, the data is shared with chapters to provide insight into where your chapter, its experiences, and performance fall within the context of the broader chapter network. This information can be helpful in identifying your chapters' area(s) of focus for the year and ways to best serve your chapter and its needs.

The 2023 survey launched in November (2023). However, the response has been minimal. Of 108 chapters, only 44 have completed the survey. In order for the data to be statistically sound and provide the greatest value, we need at least twice as many chapters to participate.

For any chapters that have not yet submitted, the survey has been reopened through **January 26 at 11:59p ET**. Emails including the link to complete the survey have been sent directly to the leaders of those chapters.

Recertification preparation tips from CBIC

For CIC® certificants with an expiration date of December 31, 2024, now is the time to review important dates for recertification. CBIC is now accepting CIC Recertification Applications for those due to recertify in 2024. Certificants can recertify either through Infection Prevention Units (IPUs) or through the untimed, open book recertification examination.

The recertification examination application can be accessed in your <u>online profile</u>. The exam must be purchased on or before November 30, 2024. A passing score must be achieved, and the recertification exam must be completed by December 31, 2024 at 11:59pm Greenwich Mean Time / 6:59pm EST.

To recertify through IPUs, sign into your profile and click on the "My IPUs" header on the top of the navigation panel. This header will only appear if you are actively certified. All active certificants can track their IPUs as soon as they become certified, however, the IPU portfolio can only be submitted in the recertifying year. The recertification portfolio must be submitted by October 31 of the year you are due to recertify.
