# Did you know your chapter activities can count toward Infection Prevention Units (IPUs)?

If your chapter hosts a single-day educational conference, you can award 5 IPUs to attendees by providing a certificate or letter of attendance. Multi-day conferences qualify for 10 IPUs.

Other educational activities, such as webinars or workshops, are eligible for IPUs on an hour-by-hour basis. Pre-approval from CBIC is not required.

Chapter leaders also earn 3 IPUs per year for their service. This includes roles such as Chapter President, President-Elect, Treasurer, Secretary, Committee Chair, and similar leadership positions.

Please note: IPUs are not awarded for social events or general chapter membership.
