What is Microlearning?

- ✓ Technique to maximize engagement and learning with short, focused lessons
- ✓ Burst of content; less overwhelming to the learner
- ✓ Short: 3 to 15 minutes in length
- ✓ Focused: 1-3 learning objectives
- ✓ Modern: mobile-friendly, accessible when and where the learner needs it
- ✓ Collaborative: community of learners and contributors

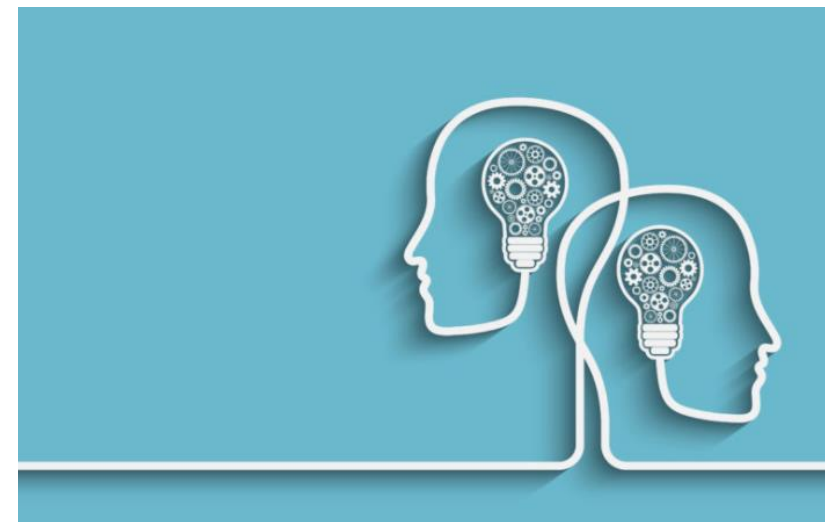
