





APIC SC Palmetto IPU Committee

Are you Certified in Infection Prevention and Control? Is this your year for recertification? There are two ways to recertify.

By Examination. The open-book recertification examination will be available through December 2025.

Note that after January 1, 2026, the recertification by exam will be by retaking the initial CIC proctored examination.

By Continuing Education of Infection Prevention Units (IPUs). Every 5 years, a minimum of 40 units/points from the projects or activities covering at least six of the eight domains.
