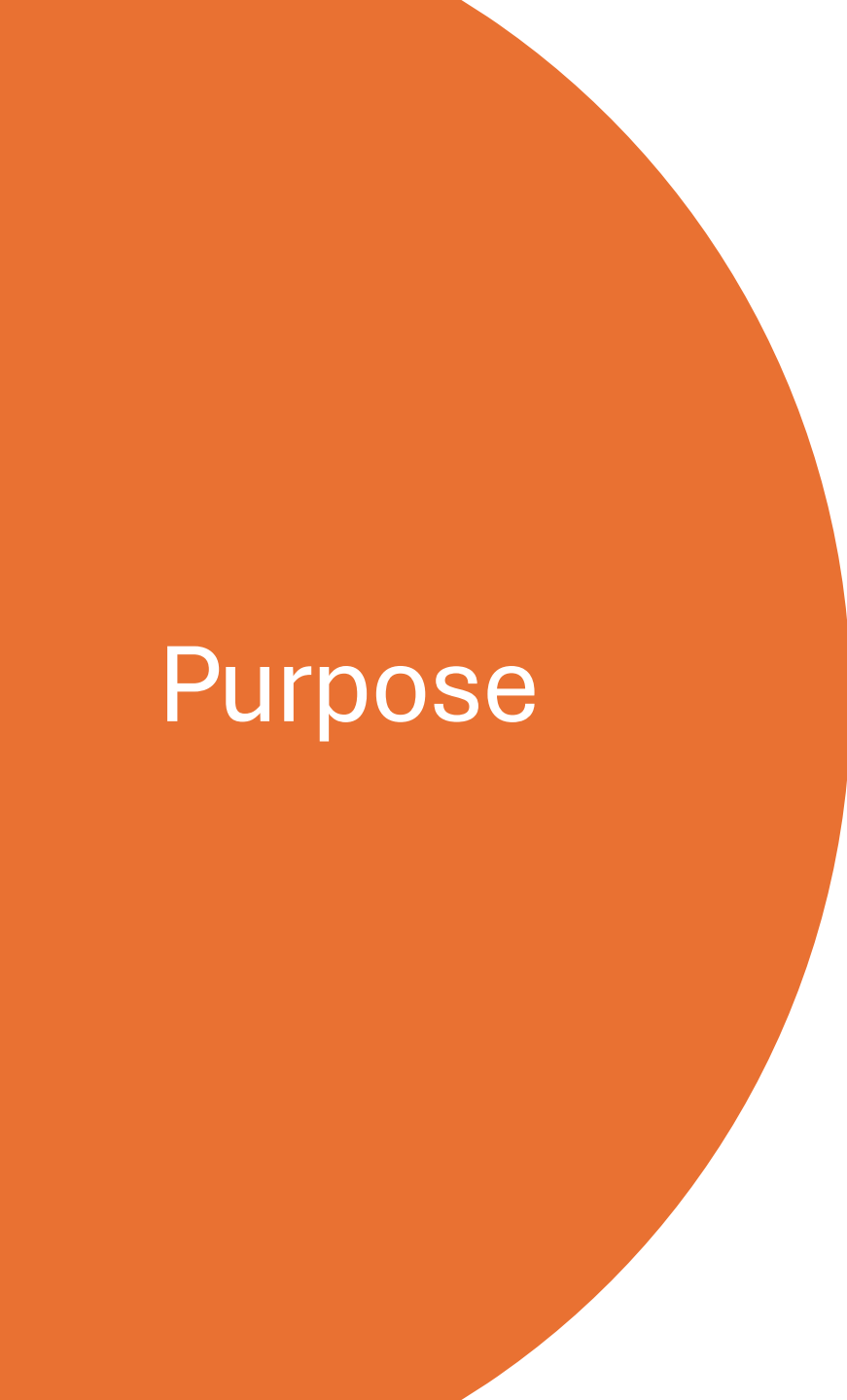

Recognizing Lifetime Excellence
and Sustained Impact in
Infection Prevention and Control



Purpose

The APIC–NC Hall of Fame Award recognizes individuals with exceptional, sustained contributions to the Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) profession. This award honors career-long excellence, leadership, and service that have had a lasting impact on infection prevention practice, the APIC community, and public health.



Eligibility Requirements



Actively engaged in the IPC profession for at least 15 years



Demonstrated expertise in three (3) or more domains of the current APIC Competency Model, including Infection Prevention and Control Operations



Member of APIC-NC for at least 10 consecutive years immediately preceding nomination



Must be an active APIC-NC member during the nomination year



Holds a current CIC® or CIC-LTP credential issued by CBIC



Award may be received once in a lifetime

Ineligibility Criteria

- Members of the APIC Nominating and Awards Committee are not eligible during their term and may not nominate, be nominated, or serve as references
- Members of the APIC Board of Directors are not eligible during their term and may not submit a nomination
- Board members may serve as reference writers only

Nomination Process

Completed APIC–NC Hall of Fame Award Nomination Form

Nomination statement describing career achievements and impact

Minimum of two (2) letters of reference

Verification of APIC membership history

Verification of CIC® or CIC-LTP status (or retirement status, if applicable)
