Let's Get Started, Step-by-Step...

1 Sign In

Go to publiclandsalliance.org. Click on the **Sign In** button in the upper right hand corner. Enter your email address and password. If you have difficulty, click the **"Forgot Password"** link and you will be sent an email to reset your password.

2 Complete Your Profile

Once you've signed in to Connected Communities, click on the gray face thumbnail in the top-right corner and click **Profile**.

- Begin by Adding a Picture.(Actions > Change Picture > Upload).
- Next, tell members something about yourself in the Bio section.
 (Add Your Info > Save).
- Review your Contact Details on the left-hand side.
 (Click on the pencil icon > Edit your Contact Details > Save).
- Complete your Education and Job History sections.
 If you have a Linkedin account, you can use the Import From LinkedIn Import Your Info link to complete your profile.

You earn points and receive ribbons when you complete your profile!



3 Enter Your Community

- Click on the My Connections tab next to My Profile towards the uppermiddle of your screen. Then, click Communities.
- > Click the Enter button on the right-hand side.
- > Choose one of the following three tasks:

Post a Message and introduce yourself!

Create a Library Entry and upload a pdf or doc to share.

Click the Members tab to view all members in the community.





- > While on the Communities page, scroll down to view Current Members.
- > Hover over a Member Profile.
- > Select Contact Request. S/he will receive a notification via email and in their profile.

CHECK OUT THE MEMBER DIRECTORY

Public Lands Alliance Members are listed in the Member Directory. You can search for a colleague by first or last name, organization, or email address. This is a great way to add Contacts and grow your network. Go to publiclandsalliance.org/community and look at the many directories listed on the right-hand side.
