



<b>Committee Charter</b>	
<b>Name/Title</b>	Member Relations Committee
<b>Committee Purpose</b>	The Member Relations Committee is charged with the overall mission to foster a strong relationship between the Applied Client Network and its members.
<b>Committee Job Responsibilities</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To increase member retention, recruit new members and reach the goal based on the Member Relations Budget.</li> <li>2. Promote and educate the value and benefits of membership in the Applied Client Network.</li> <li>3. Encourage the communication of member-related information from the Applied Client Network to the local chapters and among the local chapters themselves.</li> <li>4. Promote volunteerism within the Applied Client Network and educate and coach members on how to get engaged through mentorship.</li> <li>5. Coordinate activities with other Applied Client Network committees to increase awareness of member benefits and define new possibilities.</li> <li>6. Collaborate and communicate with the Applied Client Network Board of Directors and committees to ensure consistent, accurate and open communication channels for advancement of strategic plan initiatives.</li> <li>7. Volunteer at the Applied Client Network booth or committee table at Applied Net.</li> </ol>
<b>Committee Structure</b>	The MRC is comprised of 10+ members.
<b>Authority/Limitations</b>	The Member Relations Committee members are directed by the Applied Client Network Board of Directors and the Applied Client Network CEO. The Member Relations Committee Chair, Vice Chair and/or Committee members and participants may not enter into legal or binding agreements on behalf of the Applied Client Network without approval from the Applied Client Network Board of Directors and/or the Applied Client Network CEO. Neither Member Relations Committee Chair nor Committee members have authority over the Applied Client Network resources and/or staff.
<b>Method of Committee Member Selection/Nomination, Term</b>	Committee member term will be two years. Members are selected from the Call for Volunteers form and recommendations provided by the LEAD Committee
