
Guidelines for Conduct During Remote Discussions



Share air time equitably.

Know yourself, balance your listening and talking, even when we're discussing remotely, asynchronously or anonymously.



Value differences.

Remember that your perspective is not the only one, and that we all face different challenges.



Argue using evidence.

Back what you have to say with data.



Make sure everyone feels safe.

Safe is not the same as comfortable. Ensure that there are ways to report problematic behavior.



Discomfort is okay.

Identify your learning edge and push it. We can still find ways to learn and support each other online.



Own your impact.

Your intentions may not be the same as your impact. Positivity and respect are critical when we don't have in-person cues.



Create a sense of community.

Acknowledge others and do not isolate anyone.
