Cecilia Payne-Gaposchkin Doctoral Dissertation Award in Astrophysics

DAP is soliciting nominations for the DAP Cecilia Payne-Gaposchkin Doctoral Dissertation Award in Astrophysics. This award recognizes doctoral thesis research in astrophysics and encourages effective written and oral presentation of research results. The annual award consists of \$1,500 for the recipient, a certificate, meeting registration waiver, and all finalists will receive a travel reimbursement of up to \$750 in order to present their work in an invited session at the APS April Meeting.
